- Assist in the preparation of the **school's annual budget** and plan as required by **s. 1008.38(1)**

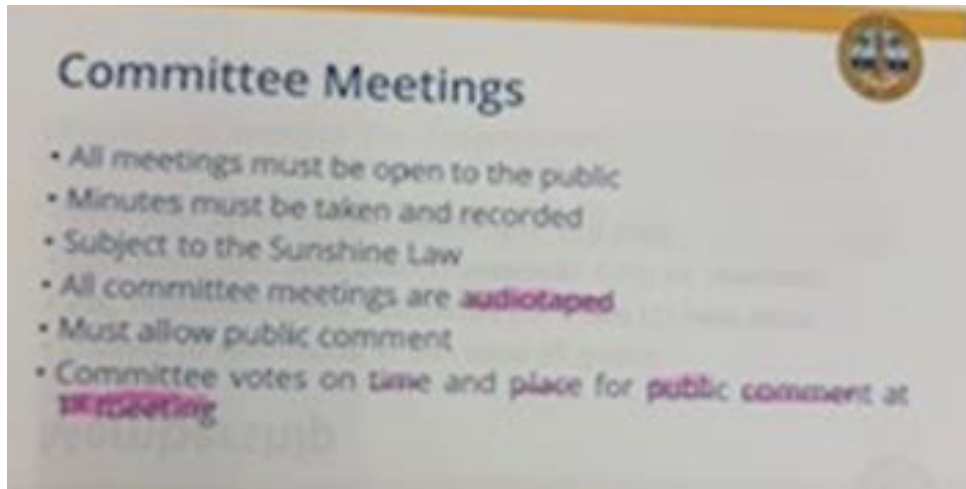
## District Advisory Committee
